Sunday worship for families

3 Nov **God's Saints** – We will be meeting in the St Alphege church building to celebrate All Saints Day. We'll be looking round the church building to see which Saints we can find and of course we'll be doing a craft activity.

17 Nov **Tree planting Sunday** – Hopefully we'll be spending time outdoors and will be making a gratitude tree. **After the Junction everyone is invited to stay and help plant trees donated by the Woodland Trust around the OBH site.**

24 Nov **Christ the King** The Junction will be joining the Sunday club at St Helen's (see below for more information)
