

OLIVER BIRD HALL – Changes in Car Parking Facilities – 01.03.25.

Significant changes will be made to the car parking facilities at the Oliver Bird Hall, with effect from 1st March, 2025, which will be managed in future by UKPS Car Parking Company. This includes the driveway between the rear of the Oliver Bird Hall and St. Alphege Church. There will be clear signage around the whole site so that people are fully informed about the change in parking facilities and failure to comply will result in a parking fine from UKPS of £100. Any appeals will need to be directed to UKPS.

It is hoped this information sheet will cover any questions or concerns but if not please email obhcarpark@solihullparish.org.uk or complete one of the query slips provided and hand to your Group Leader of the event you are attending. This will be forwarded to the Oliver Bird Hall Committee for a response. **Please note that the staff at the Parish Office are not able to take enquiries about car parking but they are a drop off point for the query slip in the event of a Group Leader not being available.**

- The current Car Parking Permit scheme offered by the Oliver Bird Hall will continue and permits must be displayed clearly on the front windscreen of vehicles. The Permits cost £15 and are available from the Parish Office or the Group Leader of the event you are attending.
- The Permits operate from 1st September 2024 to 31st August 2025 or until the final meeting of your group event. **School Permits are only valid during term-time.**
- UKPS will be monitoring the car park with their CCTV cameras and time will be allowed for people to return to their vehicles after school drop-off/collection.
- Permits must be displayed if you attend the Oliver Bird Hall on a regular basis.
- Please check your current Permit to ensure the registration number still relates to the information when the Permit was purchased. Any changes must be notified to your Group Leader or the Parish Office.
- The Church permit will cover attendance solely for the duration of Church services and events taking place in St. Alphege Church and the Oliver Bird Hall.
- For 'one-off' events, such as party bookings in the Oliver Bird Hall, a key-pad will be available to register cars and this must be used on arrival and only lasts for the duration of the event.

Contact details for UKPS will be available and the Car Parking Company can be contacted directly to appeal against a parking fine. The Parish Office staff are not authorised to respond to car parking queries.
